Creation	Causing something to exist.
Creator	The maker; God.
human	A person
The Fall	The breakdown of the relationship between God and his people.
Worship	Show love and praise to God.

The book of Genesis in the Bible (Old Testament) tells the story of the creation of the world by God.

On the 1st day God created day light. He said "let there be light" and there was light.

On the 2nd day God created the earth. He then put a vast blue sky to complete it.

On the 3rd day God added dry land, wet land, plants, trees and grass.

On the 4th day God thought he should add a light for day and a moon for night.

On the 5th day God added animals. He made fish in the sea and birds in the sky, he was very happy.

On the 6th day God created land animals and humans. The next day he rested and was proud of his work.

**The Story of the Fall** After God created the world, Adam and Eve were put in charge to be stewards of the world. God told them not to eat the fruit of the tree of Life, but Eve was tempted by the snake and they ate the apple. God was angry and threw them out of the Garden of Eden and they had to look after the world. - this is called the Fall. How can we look after the world and be good stewards?
