Autumn Term	History Romans - Mosaics Artist: Gaudi	-To create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas. - To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing , painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]	-To build on the skills learnt in KS1 -Children are studying romans in History so we have chosen to look at Mosaics so children understand how mosaics were used in buildings and architecture. during the Roman period.
Spring Term	Geography Rivers - Pointillism Artist: George Seurat	-To create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas. - To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing , painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil , charcoal, paint , clay] printing	Children will be introduced to physical geography for KS2 and to build on KS1 knowledge of rivers so we will link this to Art for Spring Term. Children will create pointillism paintings of rivers linked to the work of George Seurat.
Summer Term	History Anglo Saxons	-To create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas. - To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing , painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay] collage	-To build on the skills and techniques from KS1. - Children will create jewellery based on the jewellery create by Anglo Saxons. Children have learnt about settlements in KS1 including towns, cities, and different types of buildings. To build on this knowledge and introduce facilities and how this affects where people choose to live.
