<b>LKS2</b>			
<b>Autumn Term</b>	The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain		Geography unit to look at the local area. This will be taught before the upper school learn about the local history.
<b>Spring Term</b>			
<b>Summer Term</b>	Britain's Settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots		To follow on from the Roman Britain unit which was taught in the Autumn Term to help with the children's chronological knowledge of the history of Britain.
<b>UKS2</b>			
<b>Autumn Term</b>	Local history study – Romans (a depth study of Gloucester in the Roman times)		This will be a build on from the unit of the lower school which they will have studied. Children can share their knowledge of their learning across the school as children are learning about the Romans across the whole school. Geography unit will look at the local area and the history of this.
<b>Spring Term</b>			
<b>Summer Term</b>	The Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor		This will lead on from the unit that was taught in the lower school. The link to the lower school will allow children to recap what had happened in the history of Britain up to this point and to continue this chronological knowledge for this next unit.
