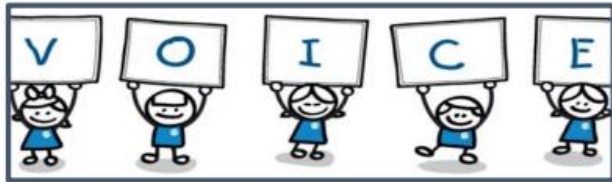


Reading - Pupil voice

“I like reading because if you are upset, it can help you feel safe and take you to a nicer place. “

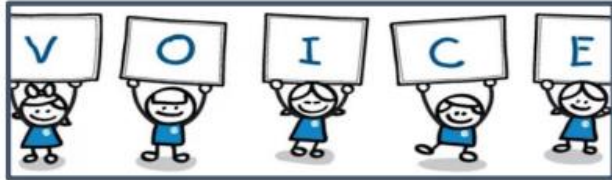
We read a lot because it helps us in life. When I am famous I could read speeches out loud! “
