Again, please make sure everything is clearly named.



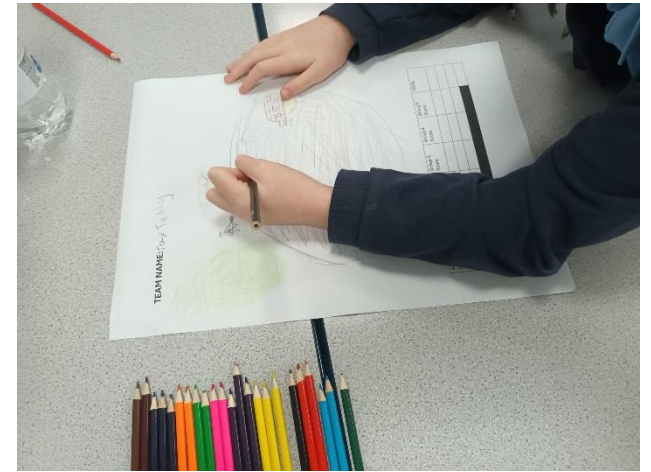
Homework
