3.20 pm – End of School Day

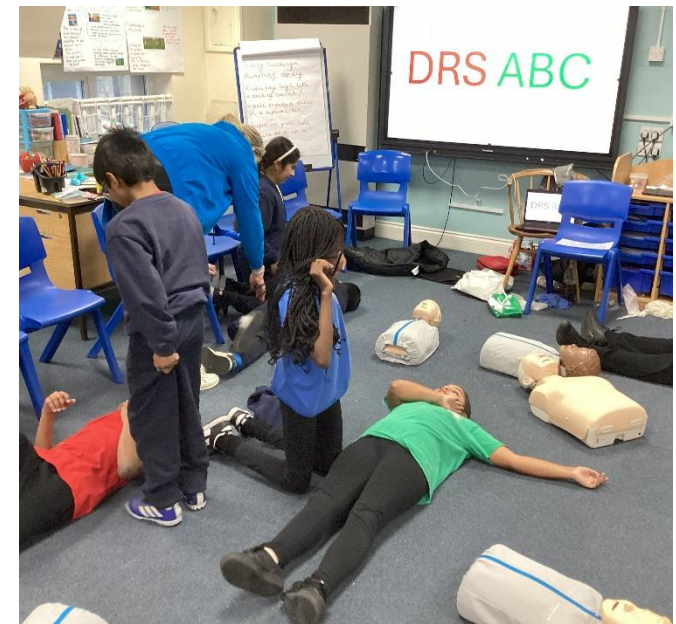


Before school

Hot Lunches are available through our caterer, Caterlink, at a cost of **£2.95 per day** unless your child is eligible for **Free School Meals**. Meals are paid for by **Parentpay**. **You will receive Parentpay login when your child starts.**

Please note children in Junior School **are not automatically eligible for Free School Meals** – please make sure you apply for these if you are entitled (this will also give the school additional funding for your children.) Details in your pack.

If your child brings in sandwiches, we do ask that their lunch is balanced and healthy – no sweets or fizzy drinks. Please make sure that it is easy for them to eat.
